

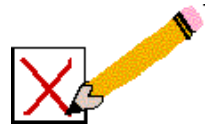

Greater Seattle Blog is Changing!

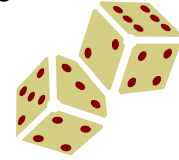
