## **What's New in SharePoint 2010 for Records Management?**

**Speakers: Tricia Bush**, as Director of the Microsoft SharePoint Enterprise Business, oversees the ECM, InfoPath, Internet Business, and SharePoint BI product management. This group is responsible for the SharePoint platform product management for large and global businesses. Bush joined Microsoft in March, 2005.

Before joining Microsoft, Bush was a principal product manager at PeopleSoft where she drove business planning and strategy for the J.D. Edwards EnterpriseOne ERP solution and integrated the marketing teams across PeopleSoft's acquisition of J.D. Edwards. Prior to PeopleSoft, Bush was Strategic Alliances Manager at Optika (acquired by Stellant who was acquired by Oracle) and held senior positions at management consulting firms including Denver Management Group (acquired by Keane Consulting) and The Revere Group.

Bush earned a master's of business administration degree from DePaul University in Chicago, IL and holds a bachelor's degree from Florida Atlantic University in Boca Raton, FL.
